

MNMC Patient Pre-Procedural COVID-19

Screening Guide

Dear Patient,

This is a reminder to monitor your health before your upcoming procedure/surgery appointment.

Call the Pre-Anesthesia Testing (PAT) office if you answer any of the below as “yes”.

0 to 21 days before your procedure or surgery day if:

- Anyone in your Household tests positive for COVID-19

0 to 10 days before your procedure or surgery day if you are:

- Exposed to anyone with COVID-19
(Exposed = unmasked within 6 feet for more than 15 minutes)

- Test positive for COVID -19

- Experiencing any of the following symptoms
- Fever or chills
 - Cough
 - Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
 - Fatigue (tiredness)
 - Muscle or body aches
 - Headache
 - New loss of taste or smell
 - Sore throat
 - Congestion or runny nose
 - Nausea (unsettled stomach) or vomiting
 - Diarrhea

**Call the Pre-Anesthesia Testing Department (PAT)
to tell them if you had any of the above marked as “yes”**
